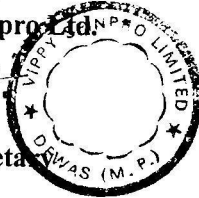

Action should be taken to contain corona: CM

State recovery rate 70% with 13,908 cases fully recovered

Chief Minister Shivraj Singh Chouhan has said that good efforts have been made in the State to control Covid-19. Positive cases are emerging due to reasons such as organizing marriage ceremonies and parties at social level, hence action should be taken to control it at both Government and social level with alertness. Social distancing, use of masks and precautions must be continued.

The causes behind emergence of positive cases must be eliminated. Chief Minister

Chouhan gave these instructions during the review of Covid-19 situation in the State today. He also conducted a separate review of Khandwa and Datia district.

Home Minister Narottam Mishra, Health Minister Prabhuram Choudhary, Medical Education, Bhopal Gas Tragedy Relief and Rehabilitation Minister Vishwas Sarang, Chief Secretary Iqbal Singh Bains, Director General of Police Vivek Johri were present at the meeting.

Chouhan said that the positive cases of Corona in Gwalior, Chambal region of the State have emerged due to contact with other neighbouring states including Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh. Symptoms of the disease were also noticed in citizens in the door-to-door survey during the Kill Corona campaign. All arrangements

to take samples of patients, their treatment and keeping them in isolation should be ensured to help them recover.

Additional Chief Secretary Health Shri Mohammad Suleman informed that improvements in contact tracing and other systems have led to better control. A total of 13,908 cases have recovered.

The State's recovery rate is currently 70.8 percent, higher than 63.2 percent of the country. Among the big States, only Rajasthan's recovery rate is higher than Madhya Pradesh.

Till Tuesday, 11 thousand 703 survey teams have conducted health survey of 75 percent population of the State in the Kill Corona campaign.

About 93 thousand samples have been taken, out of which 1611 were positive, which is 1.72 percent of the total samples taken.

Let's take education to next level, says Delhi Edu Min Manish Sisodia

Aiming to transform the education landscape of Delhi, Deputy Chief and Education Minister Manish Sisodia said 98 per cent result is not enough and all have to education to next level.

Citing Delhi's education model, Sisodia said, "Last five years showed us what we can achieve within the existing education system. Now our aim is to redefine the education system to prepare our students for the challenges of the 21st century world."

After the announcements

of Class X and XII of Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), Sisodia convened the first joint meeting of Delhi's Curriculum Reform and Delhi Education Board Committee for the designing of new Curriculum and Board for Delhi Schools.

Lauding the efforts of government teachers, the education minister encouraged his staff and said, Delhi schools have achieved success on existing educational parameters.

Sisodia announced the constitution of two committees - DEC and a committee for curriculum reforms which he

promised during the announcement of annual budget 2020-21 in Delhi Legislative Assembly.

Starting the discussion with the exemplary performance of Delhi Govt schools in Class 12 Board examinations, Sisodia said that the Team Education should start thinking of taking education to the next level, "Our Delhi Govt schools have showcased exemplary performance in class 12 board exam results. This is a reflection of the work that has been done in the last 5 years. But 98% result is not enough, we have to work together to

take education to the next level," he said.

Two panels to prepare framework for education board, curriculum reforms

Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia has announced the constitution of two committees to prepare the scheme and framework for formation of Delhi education board and curriculum reforms.

The announcement was made in a meeting convened on Wednesday. In the annual budget 2020-21, the government had announced its plans for curriculum reforms and creating a new board of education for Delhi.

Starting the discussion with the exemplary performance of Delhi government schools in Class 12 Board examinations, Sisodia said that the team education should start thinking of taking education to the next level.

"Our Delhi government schools have showcased exemplary performance in class 12 board exam results. This is a reflection of the work that has been done in the last 5 years. But 98 per cent result is not enough, we have to work together to take education to the next level," he said.

Our vision for the next five

years is to transform the education system of Delhi and these two committees constituted for the purpose.

"The committee for the creation of the framework for the Delhi State Education Board will study global best practices in learning assessment, re-imagine current assessment practices and provide a roadmap for an innovative, student-friendly scheme of assessment to be followed by the new education board of Delhi," the government said in a statement.

Current Covid-19 situation better than what it was in June: Kejriwal

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Wednesday said that the current Covid-19 situation is better than what it was in June, but the war against the disease has not been won yet. In a digital conference, Kejriwal said there are three key principles behind Delhi's model of fighting Corona. Our three principles include teamwork and collectivity, correcting the lapses when pointed out, and not losing hope," adding, "Delhi has recorded 1.15 lakh cases against 2.25 lakh estimated in Delhi by July."

Citing a report of State (Delhi) health department, he said there are only 1.15 lakh total cases and 18600 active cases in the

"One and a half month back, around June 1 when the number of Corona cases was rising, we had presented the projected number of cases of Corona as of June 30, July 15, and July 31 in front of the people. This projection was done as per the central govt's formula of identifying the number of cases in the future according to

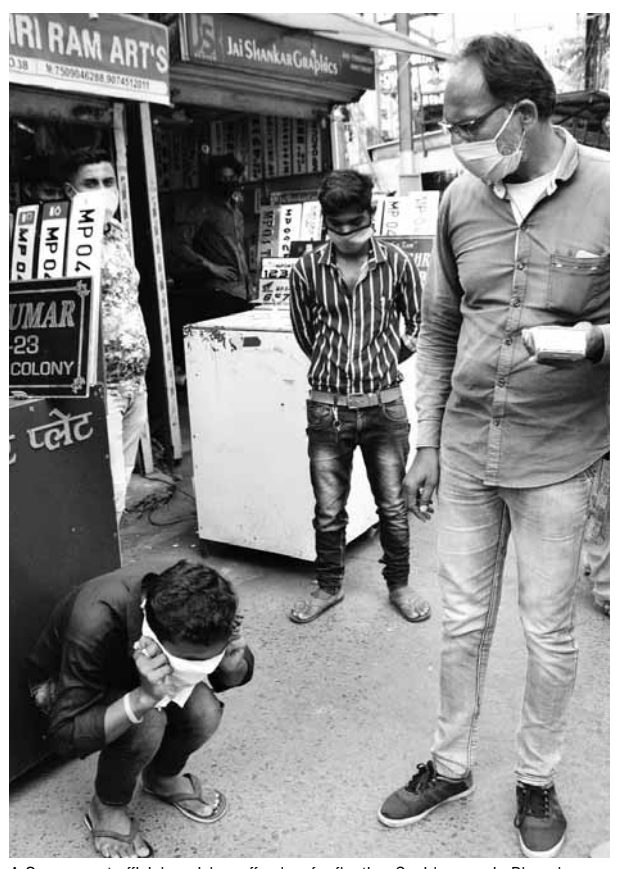
the trend at that time," Kejriwal said that as per the Centre's formula, there was a prediction of 2.25 lakh cases by July 15 according to the surge in the number of cases in the first week of June. Out of the 2.25 lakh cases, around 1.34 lakh active cases would have been active, for which 34,000 beds would have been needed in Delhi. He said, "But due to the collective efforts of all the governments, including Delhi government, central government, and the 2 crore people of Delhi, the actual number of cases is half from what we had projected till July 15. There are 1,15,000 Corona cases in Delhi, out of which only 18,600 cases are active against our projection of 1,34,000 active cases. Only 4000 beds, as against our projection that 34,000 beds would be needed. We have arranged for 15,500 beds for the treatment of Corona patients, out of which only 4000 beds are occupied and the rest remain vacant."

"The situation is under control, but as I say, we should not be complacent. The number of cases can surge at any moment. I want to thank all of

the people who put in the effort and worked hard to control the Corona situation in Delhi, especially the 2 crore people of Delhi. I believe that it is neither because of me nor because of the cabinet of ministers in Delhi, that the situation has been brought under control. It has happened because of the people, doctors, nurses, Corona warriors, who have worked day and night to control the situation without caring for their lives," he added.

Point out the death rate in the city, he said that in June, there were days when the number of deaths had climbed to more than 100, it has now come down to 30-35. He said, "We have to reduce the deaths further. We did extensive planning to ascertain the causes of deaths." The first reason was testing. Because testing was not being done on time, the symptoms increased and got severe, which resulted in the patient's death. We have increased the number of tests and people are not facing any trouble now."

He also said that more beds were subsequently arranged in the hospitals and other facilities in Delhi.

The attackers, two in numbers, had killed the family members of Rajjan Soni, who is said to be associated with the Bharatiya Janata Party.

Initial reports suggested that Soni's family had an enmity with neighbours. At around 4pm on Wednesday, Santosh and Harish of the rival family assaulted Soni and his family with sharp edged weapons. Santosh also was killed in the assault, reportedly by locals who caught hold of the attackers and gave them sound bashing after the attack.

The condition of Harish, second attacker, was said to be critical. Senior police officials including the SSP had rushed to the spot after receiving the report of this gruesome massacre. Heavy police force was deployed in the area after the massacre.

Those killed in the incident included Rajjan Soni aka Rajendra Soni, Vinod Soni, Om Soni, Priyesh Soni, Shreyansh Soni and Dinesh Soni, the police said adding Santosh Soni of another family was killed in the assault.

678 fresh cases, 7 deaths reported in Haryana, tally crosses 23K mark

The total number of Covid-19 positive cases crossed 23000-mark in Haryana on Wednesday with the state reporting 678 fresh cases. The total number of positive cases in the state stood at 23306 which include 5320 active cases.

Only a day before, the state had witnessed its biggest single-day spike with 699 positive cases. In the past few days, Haryana continued to witness spike in Covid-19 positive cases with 658 reported on July 12 and 689 cases on July 13.

Seven deaths have also been reported in the last 24 hours taking the total toll to 319 in the state.

"Out of 678 fresh cases, 216 were reported from Faridabad, 82 from Gurugram, 66 from Sonapat, 36 from Rohtak, 19 from Karnal, 34 from Hisar, 33 in Ambala, 25 in Rewari among other cases," stated Haryana Health Department's evening bulletin.

Of the seven deaths, three



from Faridabad, one each from Gurugram, Bhiwani, Panipat and Nuh have been reported in the last 24 hours in the state, the bulletin stated.

With 319 deaths so far, the fatality rate is recorded at 1.37 percent in Haryana. The case-doubling rate in Haryana stood at 21 days, Covid positive rate at 5.91 per cent, recovery rate recorded at 75.80 percent, according to the health bulletin.

Till date, 17667 patients including 577 in the last 24 hours have recovered and have been discharged from hospitals in the state. There are a total of 5320 active cases in Haryana. Among critical Covid-19 patients, 64 patients are on oxygen support while 11 are on ventilator in the state, the bul-

letin added.

Meanwhile, the cases continued to surge in the worst-affected districts of Gurugram, Faridabad and Sonapat in the state.

The total number of cases in the worst-affected Gurugram district were 7208 and 110 fatalities have been reported till Wednesday. Faridabad has recorded 58881 cases and 104 deaths while Sonapat with 2170 cases has recorded 24 deaths.

As many as four lakh samples have been tested till date in Haryana. The report of 5499 samples is awaited, it added.

Notably, the Home Minister Anil Viji had a day before hinted at imposing strict restrictions in the worst affected districts to stem the spread of Covid-19 in the state. Commenting on the surge of cases in four districts namely Gurugram, Faridabad, Sonapat and Jhajjar which are in close proximity of Delhi, he had said that we are considering imposition of curfew in these four districts.

104 new patients of Covid-19 reported in Uttarakhand

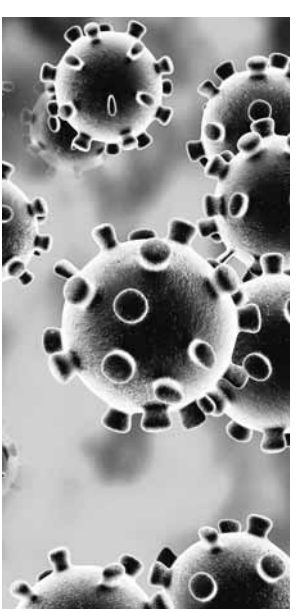
Tally surges to 3,785 in State

The number of novel Coronavirus (Covid-19) patients witnessed a big jump on Wednesday with the state health department reporting 104 new patients of the disease.

The state now has 3785 patients of the disease. On the day the authorities discharged 81 patients from different hospitals of the state after their complete recovery from the disease. A total of 2948 patients have so far recovered from the disease. The recovery rate which was in excess of 80 percent till a few days ago has now dropped to 77.86 per cent. The doubling rate of the disease is 32.86 percent.

The health department reported 52 patients of the disease from Dehradun district on Wednesday. Similarly 24



patients were reported from Nainital district.

In Uttarkashi eight patients were reported while seven patients surfaced in Pithoragarh and six from Udham Singh Nagar district. In
