JAPAN THRASH SPAIN 4-0 IN WOMEN'S WORLD CUP

Hinata Miyazawa scored twice and set up another as Japan stunned Spain 4-0 at the Women's World Cup on Monday to set up a clash with Norway in the knockout stage.

The 2011 champions Japan topped the group to play another former winner in Norway while Spain will face Switzerland in the last 16. Miyazawa's brace took her to four goals for the tournament while Riko Ueki and Mina Tanaka bagged the others for a hugely impressive Japan.

But they didn't create a single clear chance as Japan soaked up pressure and broke with pace, with lethal effect. It was a tactical masterclass from Japan coach Futoshi Ikedo, whose team denied space and time to Barcelona stars Alexia Putellas and Aitana Bonmati.

Miyazawa is also the tournament's leading scorer, although she was denied a chance to add to her four goals when replaced at halftime. A beaming Miyazawa said leading the race for the golden boot was a surprise and a "great pleasure".

World number nine Taylor Fritz shrugged off a second-set wobble to claim the sixth title of his career with victory over Aleksandar Vukic in the ATP Atlanta Open on Sunday. US number one Fritz dug deep to overpower Australia's Vukic, ranked 82nd in the world, in 2hr 16min, winning 7-5, 6-7 (5/7), 6-4.

Borussia Dortmund punished Manchester United's defensive lapses on Sunday as the English Premier League giants wrapped up their North American tour with a 3-2 defeat to the Bundesliga side in Las Vegas. A second-half strike by Dortmund substitute Youssoufa Moukoko proved the difference in an entertaining clash at the Allegiant Stadium, home of the NFL's Las Vegas Raiders.

before Diogo Dalot handed the Red Devils the lead on 24 minutes with a long-range strike. But Dortmund turned the game on its head in the closing minutes of the first half, with two goals in a minute from Netherlands international forward Donyell Malen.

Hope for future despite New Zealand's painful World Cup exit

New Zealand's proud players hope their performances at the World Cup will be a turning point for women's football in the country despite the pain of an early exit. Some of the team were in tears as the tournament co-hosts bowed out on Sunday in the group stage in front of a sell-out 25,000 crowd in Dunedin.

But the disappointment soon gave way to pride and hope for the future of football in the country. Captain Ali Riley, a veteran of five World Cups — none of which brought a win — said she didn't feel as shattered emotionally as she had following the team's previous early exits.

Former women's international Kristy Hill told Radio New Zealand she sensed the interest would be temporary. "Going into this tournament New Zealanders didn't know women's football," she said. "They kept calling the Football Ferns the White Ferns (the women's cricket team)."

With both teams having already qualified after coasting past pool opponents Zambia and Costa Rica, sixth-ranked Spain were considered the favourites to top the group. Only needing a draw to do so, the Europeans controlled the ball for long periods but they had few answers when their opponents broke with speed.

Spain coach Jorge Vilda conceded he'd been out-thought tactically. "As the head coach I'm responsible for this defeat," he said. "Yes I was surprised, they were exerting a lot of pressure. We had to break this low block that they had but we were not able to get past their lines to attack... and little by little they started scoring goals."
