Supply of sub-standard rice Sthrough ration shops to poor has emerged as a major headache for Shivraj Singh Chouhan Government in Madhya Pradesh as a State Government order issued to district collectors has suggest-ed that 73,000 metric tonnes rice failed the tests in 28 dis-

tricts.

Terming it a big scam, MPCC chief Kamal Nath on Friday demanded that all ration distributed in the Public Distribution System should be probed into.

Meanwhile, a letter written Meanwhile, a letter written to all the district collectors by Dept of Food and Civil Supplies leaked to the media suggests that around 73,540 metric tonnes of rice was found to be below standards in the e below standards in the inspection carried out by Food and Civil Supplies Corporation. Taking prompt action, the State Government has stopped

distribution of rice under PDS and has asked the collectors to return the below par rice to millers and ensure deposit of quality grain in next one week so that the PDS supplies could

so that the PDS supplies could be resumed.

A Centre's report had exposed that tests confirmed that PDS ration shops distrib-uted inferior rice among the poor in Mandla and Balaghat districts and the rice was not fit for 'human consumption'.

MPCC president Kamal Nath on Friday claimed that poultry grade rice distribution wasn't grade rice distribution wasn't limited to Manda and Balaghat districts. "It's a major scam and all the ration and other things distributed among the poor should be probed into, he said.

Singh accused Kamal Nath of not doing anything when he was 'offered intelligence input in February 2020 that inferior quality rice was brought into the State and good quality rice was supplied out of State.

Congress spokesperson Syyed Jaafar alleged that instead of acting against the guilty millers, the State Government has offered them amnesty by asking them to take back 73,000 metric tonnes of inferior rice and re-supply proper quality grain. Are those close to the BIP engaged in this game,? asked Jaafar. and the commuters do not face any problem in last mile connectivity. Virender Yadav, civil sur-geon, Gurugram, said that the health department will provide a list of all health centres that are near the five metro stations in the city. "If any passenger shows flu-like symptoms, they can be sent immediately to the public health centre," said

public health centre, sand Yadav. Necessary arrangements have been made to ensure that passengers do not gather at one place at the Metro station. Also, passengers should try not to stand at the station for

not to stand at the station for much longer. Speaking about DMRC preparations, Rishabh Singh, Assistant Manager of DMRC said, "Passengers will be ther-mal scanned at the time of entry in the station premises. Travelers who show signs of coronavirus infection will be referred to the nearest health center or COVID-19 hospital". Travelers will also be

encouraged to download the Arogya Setu App on their

mobiles.
"There will be separate gates of entry and exit at the Metro station so that passengers coming and going do not have a conflict among themhave a conflict among them-selves. A strip of one-meter dis-tance for the passengers has been designed at the station premises and there will be self-exile signage on the plat-form so that the passengers themselves will know what to do," Singh said.

(CPWD) and Indian Society of Heating, Refrigerating and Air Conditioning Engineers (ISHRAE) for operation of Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) systems will be strictly adhered to.

Transport Minister Kailash Gahlot met with Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) and transport department officials to review the Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) in place for reopening of metro services in the Capital.

After the meeting, Galhot said "We had a fruitful discussion on SOP for graded reopening of metro services with DMRC. We will ensure that the services will be restored only after putting in place all necessary precautions to contain the spread of Coronavins. It would also like to appeal to Delhites to travel only if absolutely necessary and ensure strict compliance to COVIIP protocols at a personal level."

The Metro operations in Delhi will resume in a phased manner, with staggered timings from 7th September, but will be fully operational by 12 September.

Govt, DU lock horns over funds given to colleges NEW DELHI: The Delhi government and Delhi University have locked horns over funds to deand 16 partially funded by the accounts, the govern

NEW DELHI: The Delhi government and Delhi University have locked horns over funds to the Government aided colleges. Well placed sources in the government said that the education department issues sufficient Grant - In - Aid (GIA) funds to its colleges. It is important to mention here that Delhi University and Arvind Kejriwal government have been locked in a tussle over the formation of

governing bodies in 28 colleges with 12 of them being fully fund-ed and 16 partially funded by the city government. Colleges often claim that they been unable to pay salaries to their staffs due to insufficient grants released by the government. Refuting claims of colleges, sources in Delhi gov-ernment shared the yearly fund-ing to few government aided col-leges. Interestingly, at times when

staffers of these colleges com-plain about less funds in their accounts, the government's data reveals - Delhi government's accounts, the governments data grant - in - aid (GIA) Rs 1.95 crore to Maharaja Agarsen College, Rs 2.70 crore to Acharya Asrendradev College, Rs 1.44 crore to IGIPES , 1.80 crore to Bahaskracharya College, and Rs 2.64 crore to Bhaskracharya College, and Rs 2.48 crore to BR Ambedkar College.



Doctor, aide held for giving forged Covid test reports

The Delhi Police has arrest The Delhi Police has arrest-de a 34-year-old doctor and his associate for allegedly providing forged Covid-19 test reports to people in the National Capital. Police said that the doctor had given forged Covid-19 test reports to more than 75 patients using names of several diagnostic centres in the city.

The accused have been identified as Dr Kush Bilhari Parashar, a resident of Malviya

Identified as Dr Kush Binari Parashar, a resident of Malviya Nagar, and his associate Amit Singh. According to Atul Kumar Thakur, the Deputy Commissioner of Police (DCP). South district, a complaint was received from a reputed testing lab regarding forgery of

Five more residents suc-cumbed to COVID-19 as Chandigarh reported 203 fresh cases on Friday. With this, the COVID-19 toll stood at 68

cases on Friday. With this, the COVID-19 toll stood at 68 while the total case tally jumped to 5268.

There were 2092 active cases in the city, With 222 fresh recoveries in the last 24 hours the number of recovered patients reached 3105, according to the Chandigarh Health Department's evening bulletin. With 68 deaths till now, the fatality rate in the city stood at 1.29 percent. A maximum of 41 COVID-19 related deaths were reported in the month of August. 12 fatallities have so far been reported in the month of September.

"As the reports were prepared in PDF format on a computer and same were sent to patients on WhatsApp, it was difficult to differentiate between the forged and the genuine report. Parashar admitted that he had given forged COVID-19
