Chief Minister Mohan Yadav said that it is important to educate today's youth about the lives of exemplary individuals and historical figures from Indian culture. He instructed to formulate a plan to conduct activities in co-ordination with other departments to achieve this goal.

On a pilot basis, such villages, where the spirit of goodwill, brotherhood, mutual cooperation and happiness are prominent, will be brought forward as examples. Since its establishment in 2016, the Anand Department in Madhya Pradesh has organized 3,334 programs including online Alpavram programmes witnessing participation from over 17,000 individuals. Additionally, more than 560 Anand Clubs are registered across the state, actively involved in various initiatives.

Lokayukta police nab BDA clerk red-handed accepting bribe

The Special Police Establishment of Lokayukta has arrested a BDA clerk red handed while accepting a bribe of Rs 40,000. The accused demanded a bribe of Rs 3.35 lakh for the renewal of the lease of the house. The accused was caught red handed while accepting the bribe as the first installment. A case has been registered against him under the Corruption Act. According to the information, the complainant is a resident of Piplani. He had complained about BDA's Assistant Grade 1 clerk demanding bribes in the office of SP Lokayukta

Manu Vyas. Acting on this complaint, the team led by Inspector Neelam Patwa on Friday caught BDA's corrupt clerk Tarachand Das (58) Assistant Grade 1 red handed while accepting a bribe of Rs 40,000 from the applicant Tarachand Das of number 10 in Panchsheel Nagar, Bhopal. The applicant farmer was getting tired of visiting Babu Tarachand Das for the last 6 months for the renewal of his lease. The accused was not ready to do the work without taking a bribe. Fed up with this, the applicant farmer came to Lokayukta and complained to the Superintendent of Police.

Man nabbed for assaulting doctor at Jag Pravesh hospital

A 56-year-old man has been arrested for allegedly assaulting doctors and misbehaving with nursing staff at the Jag Pravesh Chandra Hospital in Northeast Delhi's Usmampur area. This comes in the wake of protests carried out by doctors to ensure safety for healthcare workers following the brutal rape and murder of a trainee doctor in Kolkata hospital and a week after the Health Ministry issued guidelines that if any hospital staff is attacked by anyone the FIR in the matter should be filed within six hours. According to police officials on Thursday, the man had come with his 52 year old wife Sameena Khan to the hospital for treatment on Wednesday night when he allegedly assaulted doctors. The husband runs a spare part shop. He has also allegedly made a derogatory remark regarding the Kolkata case while asking why medics in Delhi were concerned about it. "What happened if a girl died in Kolkata? Why are you concerned about it in Delhi?" the FIR read. As the accused threatened the doctors and abused them, hospital staffers recorded it

because violent and started misbehaving with the doctors. "We tried to pacify him but he started abusing us and assaulted some of us. He also misbehaved with our nursing staff," the doctor said. The FIR claimed that the accused shouted on the hospital premises, hampering the treatment of other patients, and destroyed government property. He forcefully went inside the doctors' duty room and provoked other people to beat the medics, it claimed. Eight persons 221 (obstructing public service) and 132 (use of criminal force to deter public servant from discharge of his duty) were registered at New Usmanpur Police Station. Further investigation is underway, the police officer said.

1st Space Day celebrated in Bhopal's Subhash Excellence School

Man kills wife for objecting to drinking

A 32-year-old man allegedly killed his wife for regaining her objecting to his drinking habit. Police revealed that the accused, Bilu Sarkar, a resident of Malda, West Bengal, killed his wife, Shafali Sarkar (27), by strangulation to death using a pillow. The couple always argued over this issue. On August 17, they entered into a heated argument and in a drunken condition, Bilu, strangulation to death his wife by using a pillow and stuffed her into a plastic bag and dumped in Sector-52 area, Assistant Commissioner of

Police (crime) Varun Dahiyasaid. On August 18, police received information regarding a body lying stuffed inside a plastic bag in the Sector-52 area. A police team, along with a forensic team and a fingerprint print expert team, rushed to the spot to collect evidence. The body was then shifted to the morgue for further investigations, police said. The deceased's body was later identified by her mother on August 21, who informed the police that the victim's husband used to beat her on several occasions for objecting to drinking. She also said that he had killed her and his husband killed him and is absconding.

Action on pollution testing vehicles and school vans

Under the guidance of Indore RTO Pradeep Sharma from July 01, all the mobile and permanent pollution testing centers under the Regional Transport Officer Office, Indore were given necessary information and instructions to issue certificates after checking the pollution of vehicles through online method. In compliance with the said instructions, a surprise inspection of pollution testing centers was conducted, in which during the inspection of the permanent testing center of Raghunath Prasad & Company, AB Road Indore, it was found that the validity of the pollution testing authority letter issued to the center by the Regional Transport Officer, Indore expired on February 01, 2024. Even after the

expiry of the validity, pollution testing certificates of vehicles are being issued by the said center through offline method till August 06, 2024. Similarly, pollution testing certificates were being made unauthorizedly without the necessary machine in vehicle number MP09/6416 Maruti Omni Van, which were found to be issued from the online ID of Maharashtra and Haryana state. Taking action as per rules on the unauthorized issuance of pollution test certificates at the above mentioned two centers, Maruti Omni van and pollution testing machines were confiscated. Special checking of school vehicles is being done by the Regional Transport Officer, Indore. In which the speed of the vehicle, speed governor and documents are being checked.
